



PECB EMERITUS CERTIFICATION STATUS The Emeritus Certification Status is created as a recognition to the professional trajectory of our more senior professionals, to honor the individuals who have and continue to contribute to the educational spectrum of ISO and Non-ISO Standards Industry.

EMERITUS TYPES

- PECB Certified individuals who no longer practice job functions that are specific to the certification, do not need to fulfill Continual Professional Development (CPD) nor Annual Maintenance Fee (AMF) requirements.
- 2. PECB Certified individuals who continue practicing job functions need to report CPDs on an annual basis, and fulfill a minimum annual requirement of 20 hours of work experience, implementation/auditing or consulting-related experience, training, private study, coaching, attendance at seminars and conferences, or other relevant activities. However, no AMF is required.





ELIGIBILITY

The candidates must meet all requirements for eligibility. PECB will approve the eligibility of Emeritus candidates by evaluating the following criteria in the application form:

- Must be over 60 years of age
- Must have held a PECB certification for at least five years and certification is in good standing

- You can gain the certification status regardless of not practicing any job functions anymore.
- You may choose to continue practicing job functions related to the certification and still be eligible to obtain this status.
- You can retain your existing membership and dashboard access.
- You will gain a permanent "Emeritus" title.
- Recertification is not required.
- AMF is not required.
- You can always return to active certification status by simply retaking the exam and applying for certification.
