The future of education

- ◉ CD-ROM Courses: installed programs and completion of courses on a static computer;
- ◉ Mobile Learning: through phones, or digital audio players.

Online learning gives rise to many benefits in terms of convenience, lower cost, innovative technology, wide access, etc. Employed individuals, those living in remote areas, or people with low income previously were not able to attend classes because of time, distance, or financial constraints. By taking into account the context of the organization and understanding the needs and expectations of interested parties; this standard can be used by various educational institutions, including but not limited to universities, high schools, elementary schools, language schools, training organizations, and online learning institutions.

ISO 21001 ensures that the certified organizations have set in place the necessary controls, systems, and procedures to enhance the quality of educational products and services.
