

# ISO/IEC 27001:2022, WHAT IS CHANGING?

The new ISO/IEC 27001:2022 has been published on October 25, 2022. To keep you updated with the changes to the standard, PECB will be publishing the ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Transition, Lead Auditor and Lead Implementer training courses and exams.

## ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Transition course

This training course provides detailed information about the revised clauses, added and removed terminology, reduced prescriptiveness of the standard, etc., and helps you gain a thorough understanding of the difference between ISO/IEC 27001:2013 and ISO/IEC 27001:2022. ## Transition period

Candidates who have passed the ISO/IEC 27001 exam based on the ISO/IEC 27001:2013 version of the standard, can apply for the certification until **October 25, 2023**, at the latest (1-year period). After this date, candidates who would like to apply for the certification will have to take the ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Transition exam.

## Will ISO/IEC 27001:2022 changes affect my current ISO/IEC 27001 certificate?

The new updates do not impact your existing certification against ISO/IEC 27001 standard. If you have a valid ISO/IEC 27001 Implementer, Lead Implementer, Senior Lead Implementer or an ISO/IEC 27001 Auditor, Lead Auditor, or Senior Lead Auditor, you just need to maintain these certifications active by submitting CPDs and AMFs. However, we encourage certified individuals to take the ISO/IEC 27001:2022 Transition course and exam, to update their knowledge, and report the course and exam as continuous professional development (CPDs) credits, as per the [CPD Policy](#).

For ISO/IEC 27001 Foundation and ISO/IEC 27001 Provisional Implementer or Provisional Auditor, no maintenance is required. This is a lifetime certificate that has no expiration, and the updates in the ISO/IEC standard don't impact the certificate.
