Resilience enables organizations to anticipate and respond to threats and opportunities, arising from sudden or gradual changes in their internal and external context. Enhancing resilience should be a strategic organizational goal.

Organizational resilience is a relative and dynamic concept rather than a specific activity or fixed state. The factors that enhance an organization's resilience are unique to each organization. Organizations can only be more or less resilient and there is no absolute measure or definitive goal.

This two-day course will enable participants to broaden their knowledge and get involved in managing organizational resilience. During this training the participants will acquire the necessary ability to identify and address vulnerabilities before they have a material impact. Furthermore, they will gain the knowledge to provide an effective approach to integrate existing management disciplines that support organizational resilience.

A key target in public and private sectors is to minimize the effect of the consequences that emerge after natural disasters, uncontrolled or intentional incidents occur; and to enhance their ability to give a proper reaction to the needs of the affected population.
