



Technological developments have taken the world by storm, changing many aspects of our lives, including the way we teach.


Quizzes are part of the training course to increase interactivity between attendants and the training material.

Why should you attend?



- Certification fees are included in the exam price.
- ✓ In addition to the eLearning course videos, participants will be provided with the training course material containing over 450 pages of explanatory information, examples, best practices, exercises, and quizzes.
- ✓ An attestation of course completion worth 31 CPD (Continuing Professional Development) credits will be issued to the participants who have attended the training course.
- ✓ In case candidates fail the exam, they can retake it within 12 months following the initial attempt for free.
